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Moving from physical classrooms to On-Line classrooms

Basic elements in a physical classroom: the learner, the content and the teacher.

The interactions that happen between these three in a normal classroom are as follows:

- The learner and the content: Students solving the examples on topic taught by teacher.
- The learner and the teacher: Teacher explaining the topic and answering the doubts.
- The content and the teacher: Teacher prepared the topic with the help of books and other material.

Learning Dialogues or LeDs:

Teacher explaining the topic in class to students is the equivalent of such a video in a regular teaching-learning interaction within your classroom.

Following are the additional features that the video provide us apart from the regular information transmission of the content:

- Students can pause and re-play the video for better understanding.
- Transcript is provided
- Reflection activity

Learning-by-Doing Activities or LbDs:

Learning Extension Resources or LxTs:

Assimilation quizzes help in checking whether students have absorbed the basic concepts or not.

Learning experience interactions or LXIs:
